

- For the first time in its history Gallery Pangolin has invited a guest curator into the gallery, Jerwood Award winner, Lorraine Robbins.
- Six contemporary artists have been given the challenging task of creating a series of new works in response to a piece of their choice by Lynn Chadwick. Like Chadwick, all have close links with Stroud, having grown up, studied or worked in the area.
- 2011 sees the 60th anniversary of the Festival of Britain when the new and relatively unknown Lynn Chadwick exhibited his mobiles and stabiles to a massive public (over 8 million visitors).
- The exhibition provides a new context for familiar Chadwick imagery and reaffirms his status as one of the giants of the Modern era.
- Gallery Pangolin has 'stepped outside the box' to present a show which will provoke thought, opinion, discussion and debate.
- 'Strange Beasts' is running in conjunction with the Site Festival 2011, a month-long programme of artist-led projects and events in Stroud, Gloucestershire.
